Remove:

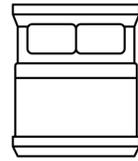
- Clutter on countertops or floors

Bedrooms

Keep:

- Decor and items you love
- Clothes and shoes worn often
- Accessories worn often

Remove:

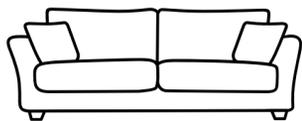
- Clutter on surfaces and floors

Throw Out:

- Anything broken
- Old clothes with rips or stains
- Old underwear, socks, and bras
- Garbage in drawers
- Old accessories
- Duplicates

Donate or Sell:

- Clothes, shoes, accessories that aren't being worn anymore that are in good condition



Living Room

Keep:

- Decor and items you love
- Throw blankets in good condition
- Furniture in good condition

Remove:

- Clutter on surfaces and floors
- Items that don't belong in a living room

Throw Out:

- Items that are broken and not functional
- Stained items like old throw blankets
- Broken furniture
- Duplicates

Donate or Sell:

- Furniture in good condition
- Decor not wanted



Dining Room

Keep:

- Decor and items you love
- Furniture in good condition
- Tableware you often use and like

Remove:

- Clutter on surfaces and floors
- Items that don't belong in the dining room

Throw Out:

- Items that are broken and not functional
- Items that don't bring you joy
- Broken furniture
- Duplicates

Donate or Sell:

- Furniture in good condition
- Decor items not wanted

Office

Keep:

- Decor you love
- Office supplies you use
- Important paperwork
- Electronics you use
- Any other items you enjoy and use

Remove:

- Clutter on surfaces
- Items that don't belong in the office

Throw out:

- Old paperwork
- Broken office supplies
- Unneeded items in drawers and cabinets
- Duplicates
- Broken furniture

Donate or Sell:

- Office decor that you do not like
- Furniture cluttering the space



Bathrooms

Keep:

- Self care items and products you use
- Makeup that's being used
- Towels and linens in good condition

Remove:

- Clutter on surfaces
- Items that don't belong in the bathroom

Throw out:

- Old towels, wash cloths, shower curtains, and any other linens with rips and stains.
- Anything broken and old
- Self care items you haven't used in years
- Duplicates
- Old makeup
- Items that don't bring you joy



Basement/Attic

Keep:

- Storage bins and label them.
- Basement furniture and sentimental items you enjoy

Remove:

- Clutter on floors and surfaces
- Items from storage bins and assess what's needed
- Items that don't belong in the attic or garage

Throw Out:

- Items that are broken (furniture, glass, old paint, and old tools)
- Items with rips and stains
- Duplicates

Donate or Sell:

- Furniture in good condition
- Electronics
- Items worth giving to someone else or selling



Garage

Keep:

- Outdoor items you use and enjoy
- Tools you use
- Car supplies being utilized

Remove:

- Clutter on floors
- Items that don't belong in the garage

Throw Out:

- Items that are broken
- Outdoor items in poor condition
- Duplicates
- Old tools

Donate or Sell:

- Outdoor items not being used like bikes, rollerblades, outdoor games, and camping gear
- Tools you don't use
